

ORDINANCE NO. 127

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE RATE CHARGE FOR WATER USAGE AND AMENDING ANY OR REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREOF AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

WHEREAS, the City of Peck is the owner of the water distribution system in the City of Peck, and

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to review and change the rate for said water usage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the basic rate for the City of Peck water users shall be TWENTY DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$20.00) for the first SEVEN THOUSAND (7,000) gallons of water used each month on each water meter for the residents of the City of Peck. That the additional amount of ONE DOLLAR AND 50/100 (\$1.50) per ONE THOUSAND (1,000) gallons of water over SEVEN THOUSAND (7,000) gallons shall be charged for each ONE THOUSAND (1,000) gallons used over the basic rate.

Section 2: That any ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby amended.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage, approval and publication.
