

ORDINANCE NO. ¹³⁰~~128~~

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 1997 EDITION OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE PUBLISHED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS PROVIDING FOR A BUILDING INSPECTOR, SETTING FORTH HIS DUTIES, DESIGNATING WHERE PERMIT FEES ARE TO BE PAID AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The 1997 Edition of the Uniform Building Code published by the International Conference of Building Officials is hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Three (3) copies of the 1997 Edition of the Uniform Building Code, duly certified by the City Clerk, shall be filed and at all times during normal business hours kept for use and examination by the public at the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3: A Building Inspector, or such an officer, be designated as having the authority to enforce the provisions of this Building Code.

Section 4: The Building Inspector shall have the authority and duty to enforce the provisions of the adopted Code and issue all permits covered thereunder. All fees for said permits shall be paid to the City Treasury unless otherwise designated.

Section 5: All ordinances in conflict herewith of the City of Peck, Idaho, are hereby repealed.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
