

ORDINANCE NO. 133

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE RATE CHARGE FOR WATER USAGE AND AMENDING ANY OR REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREOF, PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF WATER RATES BY RESOLUTION, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

WHEREAS, The City of Peck is the owner of the water distribution system in the City of Peck, Idaho; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to review and change the rates for water usage; and

WHEREAS, the City has passed a bond to make major modifications to the water system; and

WHEREAS, The City is in the process of securing loans and grants to fund the balance of the change in the water system; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the rate for the present system and to have a graduated rate increase for the new system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the basic rate for the City of Peck water users shall be TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$25), beginning April 20, 1999, for the first Seven Thousand (7,000) gallons of water used each month on each water meter for the residents of the City of Peck beginning April 20, 1999. The additional amount of ONE DOLLAR AND 50/100 (\$1.50) per One Thousand (1,000) gallons of water over Seven Thousand (7,000) gallons shall be charged for each One Thousand (1,000) gallons used over the basic rate.

Section 2: In order to finance the new water rate, the basic rate for the City of Peck water users shall be THIRTY DOLLARS (\$30) beginning July 20, 1999, for the first Seven Thousand (7,000) gallons of water used each month on each water meter for the residents of the City of Peck. The additional amount of ONE DOLLAR AND 50/100 (\$1.50) per One Thousand (1,000) gallons of water over Seven Thousand (7,000) gallons shall be charged for each One Thousand (1,000) gallons used over the basic rate.

The basic rate shall increase to THIRTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$35) beginning October 20, 1999, for the first Seven Thousand (7,000)

gallons of water used each month on each water meter for the residents of the City of Peck. The additional amount of ONE DOLLAR AND 50/100 (\$.50) per One Thousand (1,000) gallons of water over Seven Thousand (7,000) gallons shall be charged for each One Thousand (1,000) gallons used over the basic rate.

The basic rate shall increase to FORTY DOLLARS (\$40) beginning January 20, 2000, for the first Seven Thousand (7,000) gallons of water used each month on each water meter for the residents of the City of Peck. The additional amount of ONE DOLLAR AND 50/100 (\$.50) per One Thousand (1,000) gallons of water over Seven Thousand (7,000) gallons shall be charged for each One Thousand (1,000) gallons used over the basic rate.

The basic rate shall increase to FORTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$45) beginning April 20, 2000, for the first Seven Thousand (7,000) gallons of water used each month on each water meter for the residents of the City of Peck. The additional amount of ONE DOLLAR AND 50/100 (\$.50) per One Thousand (1,000) gallons of water over Seven Thousand (7,000) gallons shall be charged for each One Thousand (1,000) gallons used over the basic rate.

Section 3: Water rates, connection charges, equity buy-ins, private fire lines, turn on fees, delinquency charges, special meter readings, additional charges, and any other rates or fees for such utilities provided for by the City of Peck, Idaho, shall be amended by resolution.

Section 4: Any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby amended.

Section 5: That this ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage, approval and publication.
