

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE BY THE BIG CANYON FIRE DISTRICT, NEZ PERCE COUNTY, IDAHO PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF AREA INCLUDED WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PECK INTO THE BIG CANYON FIRE DISTRICT PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE §31-1429, PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF THE TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN SAID BOUNDARIES PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE §31-1423, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BIG CANYON FIRE DISTRICT, AS FOLLOWS:

1.0 IN GENERAL:

This Chapter shall be known and cited as the CITY OF PECK FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ANNEXATION ORDINANCE.

2.0 PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Chapter is to provide for the health, welfare and safety of the property within the boundaries of the city limits of the City of Peck, more particularly described as follows:

The dedicated town site of Peck situated in Nez Perce County, Idaho, and located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 36 North, Range 1 West, Boise Meridian; and any adjoining parcels or portions thereof that have been formally or informally annexed to the City of Peck.

3.0 AUTHORITY:

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority conferred by Idaho Code § 31-1429 providing for the inclusion, annexation and withdrawal of area in cities into organized fire protection districts. It is the intent that this Ordinance encompass the whole of these Chapters which are hereby adopted and made a part hereof. Where the Ordinance is not specific, then the statutes shall apply.

4.0 DEFINITIONS:

All words and phrases used in this Chapter, the definitions of which are not herein given, shall be given their ordinary, commonly understood and accepted meanings.

5.0 ANNEXED PROPERTY:

The taxable property within the boundaries of the City of Peck, as described in paragraph 2.0 above, shall constitute the property annexed into the boundaries of the Big Canyon Fire District.

6.0 LEVY:

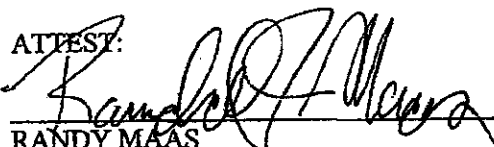
Pursuant to Idaho Code §31-1423, the Big Canyon Fire District shall cause a maximum levy rate equal to twenty-four hundredths percent (.24%) of the market value for assessed purposes to be levied to defray the cost of equipping and maintaining the district and to be used for the operation of said fire protection district and shall be added and collected to the tax bill of each said taxable property pursuant to Idaho Code §63-802(1)(a).

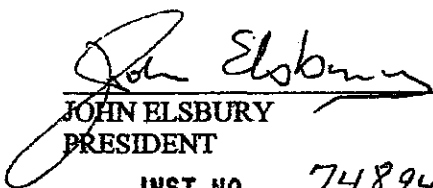
7.0 EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its adoption and upon taxes being collected pursuant to said levy process and the contract now existing between the Big Fire Protection District and the City of Peck shall remain in force until said levy had been assessed, upon mutual consent by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peck.
