

ORDINANCE NO. 172

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A HOOK-UP FEE FOR NEW WATER HOOK-UPS AND METER INSTALLATION TO THE CITY OF PECK WATER SYSTEM, PROVIDING FOR COSTS AND PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE:

WHEREAS, the City of Peck is the owner of the water distribution system in the City of Peck and,

WHEREAS, from time to time there are requests for new services on said water system.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have the authority to set rates by Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a hook-up fee of three thousand eight hundred dollars and 00/100 (\$3,800.00) to the Peck water system be set by this Ordinance. Hereafter, hook-up fees shall be set by resolution of the City Council.

- a) Full hook-up. The hook-up fee shall include the following expenses: parts including the meter, meter box, service saddle, pipe, pressure reducer, miscellaneous minor parts, equipment time and City employee labor necessary to connect the property owner to the City's water distribution system from the main water line to the property owner's property line.
- b) Meter installation only. If the hook-up requires only a new meter be installed, where a meter had been previously removed but not the total infrastructure for hook-up to the system, the hook-up fee will be \$400. This will include the cost of the meter, equipment time, and City employee labor.
- c) Extraordinary costs to be paid by property owner. The property owner shall be responsible to reimburse the City for any extraordinary costs, labor, equipment, or other expenses incurred by the City that may occur during the hook-up.
- d) City not responsible for infrastructure on private property. The property owner shall be responsible for the connection of the service line from the owner's property line to the owner's residence.
- e) Hook-up fee payment. The property owner shall pay the hook-up fee prior to the City beginning work to hook up or install a meter.

Section 2: All Peck City ordinances that conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage, approval and publication.
