

ORDINANCE NO. 178

An Ordinance entitles the annual appropriation Ordinance for Fiscal Year 2022 beginning October 1, 2021, appropriating the sum of \$243,506.00 to defray the expense and liabilities of the City of Peck for said fiscal year, authorizing a levy of a sufficient tax upon the taxable property and specifying the objects and purposed for which said appropriation is made.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Peck, Nez Perce County, Idaho.

Section 1: That the sum of \$243,506.00 be, and the same is appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Peck, Nez Perce County, Idaho for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021.

Section 2: The objects and purposes for which such appropriates is made, and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows:

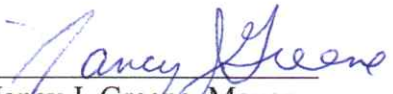

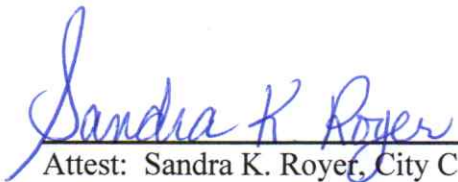
