

ORDINANCE NO. 185

An Ordinance entitles the annual appropriation Ordinance for Fiscal Year 2025 beginning October 1, 2024, appropriating the sum of \$256,335.00 to defray the expense and liabilities of the City of Peck for said fiscal year, authorizing a levy of a sufficient tax upon the taxable property and specifying the objects and purposed for which said appropriation is made.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Peck, Nez Perce County, Idaho.

Section 1: That the sum of \$256,335.00 be, and the same is appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Peck, Nez Perce County, Idaho for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024.

Section 2: The objects and purposes for which such appropriates is made, and the amount of each object and purpose is as follows:

General Fund	\$56,482.00
Community Building	\$4,363.00
Park	\$6,728.00
Library	\$15,857.00
Cemetery	\$2,961.00
Street Department	\$30,175.00
Water Department	\$115,232.00
Sanitation Department	<u>\$24,537.00</u>
Total Expenses	\$256,335.00

Section 3: That a general tax levy on all taxable property within the City of Peck be levied in an amount allowed by law for the general purpose for said city, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024.

Section 4: All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

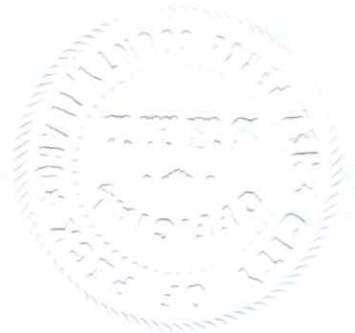

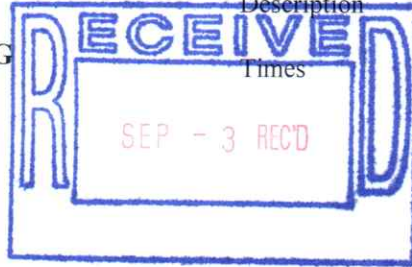
