

ORDINANCE NO. 188

An ordinance of the City of Peck, Idaho, making annual appropriations for the Fiscal Year commencing October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2026; adopting the City's annual budget; authorizing expenditures; providing for an effective date; and providing for severability.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Peck, Idaho, has prepared, reviewed, and considered the annual budget for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2026, in accordance with Idaho Code Title 50; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is necessary and proper to make appropriations for the operation of the City and its departments for said fiscal year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Peck, Idaho:

Section 1. Adoption of Budget.

The annual budget of the City of Peck for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2026, as prepared and presented to the City Council, is hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Appropriations Authorized.

There is hereby appropriated from the various funds of the City of Peck the amounts set forth in the adopted budget for the purposes stated therein. Such appropriations constitute the legal authority for expenditures by the City during the fiscal year, subject to applicable provisions of Idaho law.

Section 3. Authorization to Expend Funds.

The Mayor, City Clerk, and other authorized officers of the City are hereby authorized and directed to expend City funds and to incur obligations in accordance with the appropriations made by this ordinance and the adopted budget.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, clause, or provision of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication according to law.

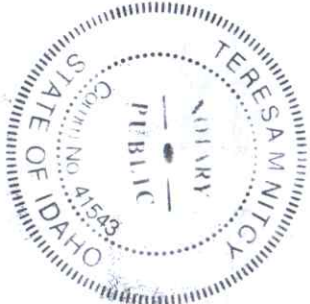
