

ORDINANCE 64

ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MANDATORY HOOK-UP TO THE PECK WATER SUPPLY AND FURTHER SETTING A HOOK-UP FEE AND A MONTHLY CHARGE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The City of Peck does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1: That any person or property using water from the City of Peck water supply on the date of this ordinance or any person or property which is annexed in to the City of Peck on or after the date of this ordinance, or any construction on or after the date of this ordinance shall be required to have a separate service connection with the City of Peck municipal water supply. No person whose premises are supplied by the City water shall furnish water to an additional person or persons.

Section 2: That the hook-up fee for such resident or residents shall be a minimum of \$150.00 plus the actual costs involved if said cost is in excess of \$150.00. This section shall not apply upon the initial hook-up to the installation of the Peck water System of which existing users which is being installed as of the date of this ordinance.

Section 3: The charge for water from the City of Peck water system shall be \$13.75 for 10,000 gallons or any amount less than 10,000 gallons and \$.25 for each 1,000 gallons in addition to the original 10,000 gallons used.

Section 4: The bill for said water is due and payable upon receipt and becomes delinquent 20 days after the billing date. After 20 days an additional 5% will be added to this billing. Water will be shut off upon issuance of a second billing. Should it be necessary to disconnect for nonpayment any water user, the entire bill must be paid in full, plus an additional \$10.00 charge to reconnect said water during the normal hours of business. Should it be necessary to reconnect said water at times other than normal hours of business, there will be an additional amount charged commensurate with the

actual cost to the City of Peck.

Section 5: Any property which is rented within the City of Peck shall be liable for the water which is used upon said property and that said liability for said water either shall be taxed against that property or the fee title or contract owner thereof. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
