

ORDINANCE 65

AN ORDINANCE EXCLUDING CERTAIN LANDS DESCRIBED HEREIN FROM THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have petitioned the Peck City Council to exclude said lands from the boundaries of the City of Peck, Idaho, and good cause appearing therefor,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That there is hereby excluded and disannexed from the City of Peck, the following described real property, situate in the City of Peck, County of Nez Perce, State of Idaho, to-wit:

Beginning at a point where the north boundary line of the Village limits of Peck intersect the East right of way line of the county road;
Thence northerly following the East right of way where said county road intersects the south right of way line of State Highway No. 9 commonly referred to as Lewis and Clark Highway, thence in a westerly direction along said right of way line to a point where said right of way line intersects the east right of way line of the Summit Grade County road in the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 37N. Range 2 W.B.M. being the point of beginning for the property to be deannexed:

Thence following the east right of way line of said county road in a southeasterly direction a distance of 180 feet to a point; thence East 60 feet to a point; thence North to a point one foot south of the south boundary of the Lewis and Clark Highway; thence West to a point one foot south of the point of beginning; thence North to the point of beginning.

Section 2: That the boundaries of the City Limits of the City of Peck be, and the same hereby are, changed to exclude the lands described hereinabove.

Section 3.: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication.
