

ORDINANCE 66

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING AND INCLUDING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AND DECLARING TO BE A PART OF SAID CITY, ALL OF THAT REAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED HEREINBELOW IN SECTION 1 OF THIS ORDINANCE, CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PECK TO INCLUDE THE LANDS SO DESCRIBED AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the lands described hereinbelow lie contingent or adjacent to existing boundaries of the City of Peck, and are not connected to the City of Peck by a mere shoestring or strip of land upon a public highway, and

WHEREAS, the owners thereof have requested annexation, in writing, to the City Council of the City of Peck, Idaho, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the City of Peck to annex the lands described hereinbelow,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described lands, lying contiguous or adjacent to the existing boundaries of the City of Peck, Idaho, be, and the same hereby are, annexed to and declared to be a part of the City of Peck, Idaho:

Situate in the County of Nez Perce, State of Idaho:

That portion of the SW1/4 of the SW1/4 of the SE1/4 of Section Eleven (11), Township Thirty-six (36) North, Range One (1) West of the Boise Meridian, described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4) of Section Eleven (11); thence North 268 feet; thence East about 50 feet across a monument on its West Bank to the center of Big Canyon Creek; thence Southeasterly upstream along the center of Big Canyon Creek to the South edge of Section Eleven (11); Thence about 150 feet West to the point of beginning.

Section 2: That the boundaries of the City limits of the City of Peck, Idaho, be, and the same are hereby changed to include the lands described hereinabove.

Section 3: That should any word, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance be declared invalid for any reason, or should any of the real property or lands annexed hereby be,

WILLIAM VERN McCANN, JR. for any reason, removed from the operation of this ordinance,

then it is the intent of the City Council that all other provisions of this ordinance be effective, notwithstanding such partial invalidity.

Section 4: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
