

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL, APPROPRIATING MONEY IN SUCH SUM AND SUMS AS DEEMED NECESSARY TO DEFRAY ALL PROPER EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, NOT OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY, 1976, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-1003, IDAHO CODE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peck, Idaho:

Section 1: That there is appropriated out any money in the City Treasury, for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Peck, Idaho, for the fiscal year beginning the first day of January, 1976, for the sum and sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary for the following amount, to-wit:
