ORDINANCE NO. 38

AN ORDINANCE TITLED THE ANNUAL AP ALLOCATION BILL, APPROPRIATING MONEY IN SUCH SUMS AND SUMS AS DEEMED NECESSARY TO DEFEND ALL PROPER EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, NOT OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY, 1977 PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 30-1003, IDAHO CODE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peck, Idaho;

Section 1: That there is appropriated out of any money in the City Treasury for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Peck, Idaho, for the fiscal year beginning the first day of January, 1977 and ending on the last day of September, 1977 for the sum and sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary for the following amount, to-wit;
