

ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY AUTHORIZED BY LAW AND DEEMED NECESSARY TO DEFRAY ALL EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO FOR THE YEAR 1978, FOR ALL GENERAL AND SPECIAL PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That this ordinance shall be known as the Annual Appropriation Ordinance.

Section 2: That the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be authorized by law as may be needed or deemed necessary to defray all expenses and liabilities of the City of Peck, Idaho, be, and the same hereby are appropriated for the general and special municipal and corporate purposes and objects of said City, hereinafter specified for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of October, 1977 and ending on the last day of September, 1978.

For special municipal and corporate purposes and objects of Peck, Idaho, from special revenues...3,500.00...Revenue Sharing...1,777.00
...General government...24,735.00...Road & Bridge...5,600.00...
Water Dept...14,600.00...Estimated total expenditures...350,215.00.
