AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEYS LOCATED IN BLOCK 20 BETWEEN ELWOOD STREET AND CANFIELD STREET AND MAY STREET AND PINE STREET, IN BLOCK 21 BETWEEN ELWOOD STREET AND CANFIELD STREET AND MOORE STREET AND MAY STREET, IN BLOCK 27 BETWEEN CANFIELD STREET AND LULU STREET AND MAY STREET AND PINE STREET, AND IN BLOCK 28 BETWEEN CANFIELD STREET AND LULU STREET AND PINE STREET AND MARION STREET, AND IN BLOCK 59 BETWEEN HOWARD STREET AND ELEANOR STREET AND MAY STREET AND PINE STREET, AND IN BLOCK 60 BETWEEN HOWARD STREET AND ELEANOR STREET AND PINE STREET AND MARION STREET, AND IN BLOCK 68 BETWEEN ELEANOR STREET AND THE CITY LIMITS OF PECK, IDAHO, AND PINE STREET AND MARION STREET, TO THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO CAUSE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE TO BE RECORDED AT THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF NEZ PERCE COUNTY, IDAHO; AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the owners of the real property abutting the alleys between Elwood Street and Canfield Street and May Street and Pine Street in Block 20, between Elwood Street and Canfield Street and Moore Street and May Street in Block 21, between Canfield Street and Lulu Street and May Street and Pine Street in Block 27, and between Canfield Street and Lulu Street and Pine Street and Marion Street in Block 28, and between Howard Street and Eleanor Street and May Street and Pine Street in Block 59, and between Howard Street and Eleanor Street and Pine Street and Marion Street in Block 60, and between Eleanor Street and the City Limits of Peck, Idaho, and Pine Street and Marion Street in Block 68, public streets of the City of Peck, Idaho, particularly described in Section 1 hereinbelow, having petitioned the Peck City Council to vacate said alleys, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on said petition was held on

~~January~~ 13th, 1978, and written notice of said public hearing was
_____ posted _____ at least ten (10) days prior to the date of
said public hearing, to all property owners within three hundred (300)
feet of the area described in the petition, and such notice was _____ posted
_____ in three different public places in the City of Peck

the date of said hearing, and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Peck City Council
that it is in the best interests of the City of Peck and its inhabitants
and of the property abutting said alleyways particularly described in
Section 1 below, that said alleys be vacated as public streets of the City
of Peck,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the alleyways in Blocks 20, 21, 27, 28, 59, 60
and 68, in the City of Peck, Nez Perce County, Idaho, particularly
described as follows:

The alleyways approximately fifteen (15) feet in width in
Block 20 between Elwood Street and Canfield Street and
May Street and Pine Street, in Block 21 between Elwood
Street and Canfield Street and Moore Street and May
Street, in Block 27 between Canfield Street and Lulu Street
and May Street and Pine Street, and in Block 28 between
Canfield Street and Lulu Street and Pine Street and Marion
Street, and in Block 59 between Howard Street and Eleanor
Street and May Street and Pine Street, and in Block 60

between Howard Street and Eleanor Street and Pine Street and Marion Street, and in Block 68 between Eleanor Street and the City Limits of Peck, Idaho, and Pine Street and Marion Street,

be, and the same are hereby, vacated as public ~~streets~~^{Alleys} of the City of Peck, Idaho, and said ~~streets~~^{Alleys} shall revert to the owners of the adjacent real property.

Section 2: That the City Clerk be, and is hereby authorized and directed to cause a certified copy of this ordinance to be recorded at the office of the Recorder of Nez Perce County, Idaho.

Section 3: That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and are hereby, authorized to execute and deliver, upon request therefor, a quitclaim deed in and to the City's interest in said ~~streets~~^{Alleys} to the abutting property owners, as their respective rights may appear.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication.

WHEREAS, a public hearing on said petition was held on February 13th, 1978, and written notice of said public hearing was posted at least ten (10) days prior to the date of said public hearing, to all property owners within three hundred (300) feet of the area described in the petition, and such notice was posted in three different public places in the City of Peck thirty days prior to the date of said hearing, and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Peck City Council

that it is in the best interests of the City of Peck and its inhabitants and of the property abutting said alleyways particularly described in Section 1 below, that said alleys be vacated as public streets of the City of Peck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the alleyways in Blocks 20, 21, 27, 28, 59, 60 and 68, in the City of Peck, Nez Perce County, Idaho, particularly described as follows:

Section 2: That the City Clerk be, and is hereby authorized and directed to cause a certified copy of this ordinance to be recorded at the office of the Recorder of Nez Perce County, Idaho.

Section 3: That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and are hereby, authorized to execute and deliver, upon request therefor, a quitclaim deed in and to the City's interest in said alleys to the abutting property owners, as their respective rights may appear.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
