

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PECK, NEZ PERCE COUNTY, IDAHO
PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 133 AMENDING WATER RATES AND PROVIDING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Peck is the owner of the water distribution system in the City of Peck, Idaho; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to review and change the rates for water usage; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the review of the City Council, it is necessary to increase the basic rate beginning October 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, there are households that are in a voluntary disconnect water status because the residents have asked to be disconnected from the water system because the house is vacant and the water is not being used.

WHEREAS, when households request the City of Peck to disconnect and reconnect their water meters due to the house being vacant and subsequently reoccupied a fee should be charged.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City of Peck, Nez Perce County, Idaho as follows:

Section 1: The basic rate, beginning October 1, 2011, shall be FIFTY-EIGHT DOLLARS and NINETY TWO CENTS (\$58.92) for the first 10,000 gallons of water used each month on each water meter for the residents of the City of Peck.

Section 2: The additional amount of ONE DOLLAR FIFTY (\$1.50) CENTS per 1,000 gallons of water over 10,000 gallons used each month shall be charged for each 1,000 gallons used over the basic rate.

Section 3: The households that are in a voluntary disconnect water status shall be charged one-half (1/2) the basic rate while disconnected or TWENTY-NINE DOLLARS and FORTY SIX CENTS (\$29.46) per month while service is disconnected.

Section 4: Households that have requested the City of Peck to disconnect and reconnect their water meters shall be charged a fee of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) for each disconnect or reconnect actions.

Section 5: This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
