

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PECK, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, PROVIDING THAT A METAL DESK OWNED BY THE CITY BE DECLARED SURPLUS AND DONATED TO VFW POST 3296 OR DISCARDED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Peck is the owner of a metal desk that is no longer needed by the city; and

WHEREAS, for the purpose of conservation of usable space on city real property and/or in city buildings, the City Council deems it in the public interest to divest this item of personal property,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PECK, NEZ PERCE COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The metal desk is not needed by the city for any purpose and is hereby declared surplus property.

Section 2: The item is of an age and condition that it has little or no monetary value.

Section 3: The Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post 3296 located in Orofino Idaho has expressed an interest in the desk.


Section 4: The desk should be donated to VFW Post 3296 on an "as is" basis.
