

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PECK, NEZ PERCE COUNTY, IDAHO TO AMEND THE EXISITING WATER RATE ORDINANCE; MODIFY THE BILLING PROCESS, AND PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Peck is the owner of the water distribution system in the City of Peck, Idaho; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to review and change the rates and billing procedures for water usage; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to ensure billing practices are fair and equitable and beginning with the billing cycle that will be mailed on or about March 1, 2018, the base rate will change to FIFTY-SEVEN DOLLARS and EIGHTY-NINE CENTS (\$57.89) for each water meter attached to the City's Water Distribution System; and

WHEREAS, each household will be charged TWO DOLLARS and SEVENTY-THREE CENTS (\$2.73) for every 1,000 gallons of water used each month on each water meter for residents of the City of Peck; and

WHEREAS, there will no longer be one-half (1/2) base rates for households that are in a voluntary disconnect water status. Those households shall be charged the base rate regardless of their disconnected status voluntary or otherwise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Peck, Nez Perce County, Idaho as follows:

Section 1: Beginning with the billing cycle that will be mailed on or about March 1, 2018, the Base Rate on each water meter for the residents of the City of Peck shall be FIFTY-SEVEN DOLLARS and EIGHTY-NINE CENTS. (\$57.89)

Section 2: The additional amount of TWO DOLLARS and SEVENTY - THREE CENTS (\$2.73) will be charged for each 1,000 gallons of water used each month.

Section 3: This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval
