RESOLUTION NO. 2025-03

A RESOLUTION SETTING WATER RATES, PENALTIES, AND ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS FOR THE CITY WATER SYSTEM; AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEAL OF PRIOR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS:

- The City of Peck, Idaho, operates and maintains a municipal water system for the benefit of its residents; and
- Idaho Code § 50-334 authorizes cities to establish and enforce utility rates and charges by resolution; and
- The City Council finds it necessary to adjust and formalize water service rates, delinquency penalties, and fines to ensure sustainable operation and maintenance of the water system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Peck, Idaho:

SECTION 1. Water Rates

Effective 10/01/2025, the following monthly base rates shall apply:

SECTION 2. New water hook-up costs

1. The cost for connection to the City of Peck system is based on current market prices for parts and labor.
2. There are parcels of undeveloped land within city limits that may require a booster station to provide adequate water pressure. The city will not pay for the cost of constructing a booster station to supply water. People purchasing property within the City of Peck should contact the city to determine the feasibility of getting hooked-up to city water.
3. The City will provide an estimate for supplying water to new properties.

SECTION 3. Penalties and Late Fees

1. Late Fee: A 10% penalty shall be added to any unpaid balance after 30 days of the billing date.
2. Disconnection Notice: A shut-off notice shall be issued after 30 days of non-payment.
3. Shut-Off/Reconnection Fee:
 - a) Shut-off: \$50.00
 - b) Reconnection: \$50.00 will only be done during business hours
4. Customers will be notified on Monday via shut-off notice and water service will be turned-off on Wednesdays if payment is not received in full.

SECTION 4. Fines for Violations

1. Unauthorized Connection: \$250.00 fine per occurrence
2. Tampering with meters, valves, or any other portion of the water system will incur a \$500.00 fine and cost of repair
3. Unauthorized use of fire hydrants
 - a. 1st within a calendar year \$500
 - b. 2nd within a calendar year \$750
 - c. 3rd within a calendar year \$1000

SECTION 5. Appeal Process

Customers may appeal charges or penalties in writing to the City Clerk within 10 days of the notice. A decision shall be rendered by the mayor or designated official within 15 days.

SECTION 6. Repeal

Any prior resolutions or rates, penalties, and fines in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. Effective Date

This resolution shall take effect and be in force as of 07/01/2025.

SECTION 8: Fees for Inefficient funds

The City of Peck will charge an additional fee for any check returned for insufficient funds.

- a. First returned check will be a \$25.00 fee.
- b. The second returned check will be a \$50.00 fee and a requirement of cash or money order only for further payments.
