**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PECK, IDAHO, AMENDING RESOLUTION 2025-03 TO CORRECT THE UNIT OF MEASURE FOR THE EXCESSIVE USE CHARGE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Peck adopted Resolution No. 2025-03 establishing water rates and charges; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2025-03 contains a clerical error in the description of the Excessive Use Charge, stating the charge applies "per gallon" rather than the intended and approved unit of "per 1,000 gallons"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to correct the unit of measure to accurately reflect the rate as adopted and applied by the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Peck, Idaho, as follows:

1. Amendment.

Resolution No. 2026-03 is hereby amended so that, in the Excessive Use Charge column, the charge shall read:

"\$3.64 (10k) per 1,000 gallons over"

and not "per gallon" for all charges enumerated in that column.


2. No Other Changes.

Except as expressly amended herein, all other terms, rates, and provisions of Resolution No. 2025-03 shall remain in full force and effect.

This amendment shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
