RESOLUTION NO. 2026-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PECK, NEZ PERCE COUNTY, IDAHO TO AMEND THE EXISTING SANITATION COLLECTION RATE TO TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) PER OCCUPIED DWELLING, PROVIDING THAT SANITATION FEES ARE ASSESSED PER OCCUPIED DWELLING, DEFINING "OCCUPIED DWELLING" AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Peck is authorized to establish and collect fees for the provision of sanitation and solid waste collection services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that sanitation collection fees shall be assessed on a per occupied dwelling basis in order to fairly allocate the costs of providing sanitation services; and

WHEREAS, the costs associated with providing sanitation collection services have increased, making it necessary to adjust the sanitation fee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to define the term "occupied dwelling" for purposes of assessing sanitation collection fees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Peck of Idaho as follows:

Section 1. Assessment of Sanitation Collection Fees.

Sanitation collection fees within the City of Peck shall be assessed per occupied dwelling. Each occupied dwelling receiving or eligible to receive sanitation collection services shall be subject to a separate sanitation collection fee.

Section 2. Sanitation Collection Fee Amount.

The sanitation collection fee is hereby established in the amount of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per sanitation tote per occupied dwelling, to be billed in accordance with billing policies and procedures adopted by the City.

Section 3. Definition of Occupied Dwelling

For purposes of this resolution and the assessment of sanitation collection fees, the following definition shall apply:

"Occupied dwelling" means a structure or portion thereof used or intended for residential purposes, that is occupied as a residence by one or more persons at the relevant time, or is regularly inhabited and not abandoned. Physical presence at a given moment is not required, provided the dwelling is maintained as a place of habitation and the occupants have an intention to return.

Section 4. Applicability.

This sanitation collection fee shall apply to all occupied dwellings located within the corporate limits of the City, unless exempted by law, ordinance, or resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date.


This resolution shall take effect on February 10, 2026, and shall apply to all sanitation collection billing periods beginning on or after that date.
